SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Serves as any certified teacher in the area of technical theatre instruction, as well as supervision of all technical aspects of student productions.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

The work is performed while standing or walking. It requires the ability to communicate effectively using speech, vision and hearing. The work requires the use of hands for simple grasping, pushing and pulling of arm controls, and fine manipulations. The work at times requires bending, squatting, crawling, climbing, reaching, with the ability to lift, carry, push or pull reasonable weights. The work requires being around moving machinery, exposure to marked changes in temperature and humidity, driving automotive equipment and exposure to dust, fumes and gases. It also requires work in our catwalk and fly system areas, changing weights for shows, 70 feet up.

1. Bachelor's degree in theatre, related field, or can meet KY EPSB alternative certification requirements or hold a valid teaching certificate.
2. Background in professional theatre as Scenic Designer/Technical Director and/or properties designer.

4. Familiarity with all production aspects of technical theatre.
5. Ability and willingness to relate successfully with students while coordinating multiple production schedules
6. Available for night and weekend performances
